


Notes on the Piano, Whole Steps and Half Steps


Please review our Theory Anthology chapters 4, 5 and 6 before you start.

A. Identify the note marked with a dot. It the note is a black key give both possible enharmonically equivalent names (e.g. A^{\sharp} / B_{\flat})




B. Mark three notes on the piano. If there are more than one possible places to mark a note, just pick one. :)
