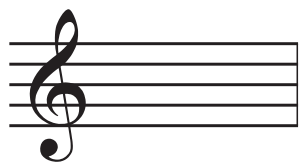


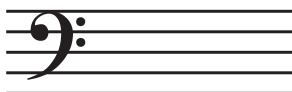
A check-plus is worth one extra point on your final grade. Check is a half point, check-minus is no points.

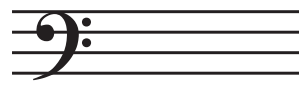

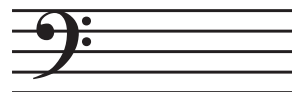

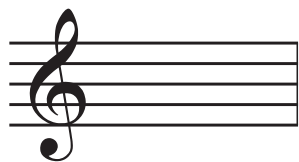
