

Even more treble clef practice

This is a set of treble-clef notes that is intended for written practice (unlike our official Level Up packet, which I try to discourage you from writing in.) Label each note with its letter name (A, B, C etc.)

LEVEL ONE - THE ANCHOR PITCHES

Since we know about the high C (with two ledger lines) lets throw that into the mix as well.



LEVEL TWO - NEIGHBOR FIGURES



LEVEL THREE - INCOMPLETE NEIGHBORS



NEW LEVEL FOUR - SKIPPING IN THIRDS



C A C C E C G E G G B G

Now we make the same pattern as level two, with an anchor note, nearby note, and return, but we skip by thirds instead of steps.
